

Moshe Schwab has been a Bible teacher for almost 50 years and has written over a hundred articles and teachings on understanding the Bible, applying the scriptures, and prayer. He has extensively studied the Bible from the Greek as well as with a Hebraic understanding. History

Moshe Schwab also known as Michael Schwab grew up in a home that wanted to pass on good values. His father taught the family about God's feasts (also known as Jewish feasts) and his mother was partial to her Jewish ancestry and taught Moshe stories from the Torah as he was growing up. They avoided talking about their Jewish connections perhaps because of the Jewish holocaust or perhaps they wanted to fit into the society at that time.

His brother was working in San Francisco where his brother believed in the Jewish Messiah through Jews for Jesus. He invited Moshe to church when he returned home. Moshe had previously believed that Yeshua was the Messiah, but his brother's invitation began a different journey of faith for Moshe. He met his wife at the congregation he attended.

Moshe has worked in several fields related to his degree in Electronic Engineering, and served as a Bible teacher and in various capacities and ministry services in the churches he attended. Among those things were leading meetings and teaching at other churches both in the United States and abroad. He has 2 Bible degrees and has worked some toward his doctorate in Religious Studies. His wife also has a degree in Biblical Studies and is a veterinarian.

After obtaining his master's degree, he asked God what he should do and God told him to go get a job where they treat Me (God) as a business. He immediately told God that is not how he wanted to use his life. So, he began serving and using his life for God and looking for opportunities to serve God in various ways. Also, after Moshe got his degree, he had a vision from God. In this vision, he stepped onto a gold platform and Yeshua laid a tallit (a Jewish prayer shawl) on him.

After doing some extensive Messianic Jewish study and learning Hebrew, he thought God wanted him to begin writing about the things he was learning to help others understand the Bible in its original context. That is the way we should all understand the Bible.

It was at this time that the leader of the Jungle churches in the Amazon Jungle told Mike that he saw him as Moses. This was somewhat startling to him as this person is a very anointed person who lived his life hearing from and following the lead of the Holy Spirit. Then, a prophetess in the United States told him the same thing shortly after this other word from God; she had no idea what the other person had said to him.

So, Mike, as his friends mostly call him decided to use Moshe as his pen name. Now some regularly call him Moshe. He continues to write and to lead Congregation Teshuvah to help people understand the truths of the Jewish Bible (the whole Bible both old and new is Jewish), and to help people believe on the Jewish Messiah Yeshua and to live how the early believers in Yeshua would have. God designated that a Messiah would come from the Jews and lead the people of the world to God.
