Our Goal Explained

We want to be a people who value the truths of the Bible and we want to live the way the God of the universe wants us to live through an authentic understanding of the scriptures.

We believe that the Bible and the true God can give people great peace and blessings. We believe that God is not distant from this world, but active in it and in our lives to bring His goodness into the world through the truths of the Bible and by His power. We want to be a people who are in fellowship with God by living the way our creator God wants us to live and by valuing the Bible the way it was originally intended to be understood. We seek to live in relationship with the God of the universe and live godly, good, and biblically founded relationships with one another.

We live with a constant desire to turn towards our God and King to the best of our ability in the present and to live and be restored in relationship with God. We understand that the complete fulfillment of that relationship will not take place until the future kingdom comes at the end times. So, in the present we apply ourselves to live the way God wants us to live according to the truths of the Bible.

Yĕhōvāh is the name of God as seen pointed as Yĕhōvāh in 2,363 manuscripts and attested to by the ancient Rabbis and even the Christian "Church Fathers." God said, "This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations;" Exodus 3:15 NKJV. Yĕhōvāh is an acronym which means, "He existed, He exists, and He will exist." It is not true we are not to say His name; Yĕhōvāh is used in the Old Testament portion over 6,000 times and also in the Hebrew New Testament portion manuscripts. To never to use God's name as Yĕhōvāh dishonor's Him. I have seen God's name pointed as Yĕhōvāh in a copy of the Aleppo Codex which is supposed to be one of the most accurate manuscripts of the Old Testament portion of the Bible. God's name was left pointed (as a copiers mistake – they simply forgot not to add the vowels) some 50 times in the Aleppo Codex.
