(by sighting 1st crescent of moon – Orthodox uses set months)

Rosh Hashanah

Evening of 9/27 Orthodox – 9/25

Yom Kippur

Evening of 10/6 Orthodox – 10/4

Sukkot

Evening of 10/11 Orthodox – 10/9

Eighth Day Shmini Atazeret, Begins Evening of 10/18

Also for

Chanukkah 12/19 Orthodox – 12/18

The set calendar of the Orthodox means that they don't actually celebrate God's feasts on the right day.
